V. Reporting situations of discrimination

In accordance with paragraph 1 of article 13 of DL no. 83/2018, of October 19, whenever a person with a disability is the subject of less favorable treatment than that which is, has been or will be given to another person in a comparable situation, which substantiates discriminatory practices against people with disability, foreseen and punished under the terms of article 4 of Law no. 46/2006, of 28 August, that person may file a complaint, in accordance with the provisions of Decree-Law no. 34/2007, of 15 February .

Annually, the INR, I.P. prepares an annual report on the application of the law that prohibits and punishes discrimination based on disability and the existence of an aggravated health risk (Law no. 46/2006, of 28 August).
